

## All these things are possible in Faulkton

- **Airport** - with a lighted 3,350 foot runway. It is located on the east edge of town and can accommodate air ambulance, small private aircraft and small jets.
- **Arts and Crafts Festival** - held annually the third Saturday of October with booths of handcrafted products.
- **Ball Fields** - three ball diamonds, two for softball and one for baseball, with grass infield.
- **Bird Watching** - especially at the Great Blue Heron Rookery located 4 1/2 miles east of Faulkton and a half mile north on the west side of a scenic country road.
- **Boating** - and other water sports at Lake Faulkton.
- **Bowling** - four lane bowling alley with winter leagues and open bowling at Casino Lanes.
- **Camping** - sites available at Lake Faulkton or at the Faulkton City Park (hookups and dump station available) or at RV parks in Faulkton.
- **Carousel** - Ride on a historic 1925 C.W. Parker electrically operated carousel (summer season only, donations welcome).
- **Centennial Mural** - Located on the inside panels of the Happy Times Carousel building. It was originally designed and painted as an outside mural in 1990 and has now been transferred inside the carousel cover.
- **Faulk County Courthouse and Murals** - Built in 1905, this three story structure features Roman-style architecture. In the third floor working courtroom are Charles T. Greener (South Dakota pioneer artist 1870-1935) judicial murals. Open to the public during regular business hours.
- **Faulkton Community Center** - Built in 2004, offers large community room for meetings/receptions; for reservations call Faulkton City Office 598-6515. Gymnasium and exercise room also available; for reservations or pass key membership to the exercise center contact Faulkton School at 598-6266.
- **Faulkton Development Board** - PO Box 458, Faulkton, SD 57438 for information.
- **Fishing** - all seasons at several area lakes.
- **Four-H** - Many 4-H Clubs. Participate here at the annual Town' Country Days combined with open class exhibits
- **Golfing** - at Lakeside Country Club on 9 grass greens and watered fairways. Course adjoins Lake Faulkton.
- **Historic Markers and Homes**
  - Gov. Frank M. Byrne (8th Governor of South Dakota) historic marker on the east edge of Faulkton.
  - Dr. William Edgerton Home (1095 Queen Anne Style Victorian home) privately owned at 308 South 10th Ave.
  - LaFoon historic marker, designates the first county seat of Faulk County, five miles east on Hwy 212 and 1/2 mile north.
  - Pickler Mansion (see museums).

- Gov. Frank M. Byrne Home - privately owned at 1017 St. John Street.
- H.O. Turner Home (early States Attorney of Faulk County) - privately owned at 1006 Main (Hwy 212).
- **Hunting** - pheasants, ducks, geese, grouse, mourning doves and deer provide good hunting every fall. Abundant CRP, wetland and grassland easements and walk-in hunting.
- **Library** - Faulk County Library open Monday-Saturday and offering internet services.
- **Movies** - May-October on weekends only, at the Lyric Theatre.
- **Museums** - *Pickler Mansion* - "Pink Castle" 20 room completely furnished home of John and Alice Pickler, one of South Dakota's first U.S. Congressmen and a noted suffragist, respectively. Construction completed in 1894, currently under restoration. Open daily 1-4 p.m. Memorial Day through Labor Day, other times by appointment. Admission charged.
- Faulk County Museum* - features artifacts, clothing and furniture from Faulk County pioneer days. Open Wednesday and Friday afternoons in season or by appointment. Free admission, donations welcomed. Located on Court Street next to Happy Times Carousel Park.
- Maloney School Museum* - bygone school days preserved in a one-room country schoolhouse completely restored. Open summer season only by appointment.

- **Picnic Shelters** - City Park and Lake Faulkton.
- **Playgrounds** - at the City Park, on the school grounds, and at ball diamonds.
- **Rodeo Grounds** - site of the annual 4th of July bull riding sponsored by the Faulk County Saddle Club. For further information write: c/o Saddle Club, PO Box 476, Faulkton, SD 57438.
- **Shopping** - in our great business community.
- **Snowmobiling** - Local club: Dakota Ditch Drifters.
- **Sports** - At the Faulkton School or sports complex include football, basketball, track, baseball, softball, volleyball, and wrestling.
- **Swimming** - Municipal pool and Lake Faulkton.
- **Trap Shooting** - five miles east of Faulkton.
- **Wild West Days** - over the Fourth of July, including a parade, barbecue, bull riding and fun for the whole family.

### Faulkton Municipal Swimming Pool

Built new in 2003 the heated Faulkton municipal pool features a wading pool, zero entry area, waterslide and diving board. Red Cross swimming lessons available.



### Pink Castle – Pickler Mansion

Tour this National Register 20-room home complete with original furnishings from the 1890's. Nicknamed the "Pink Castle" for its distinct pinkish color chosen by pioneer artist Charles T. Greener in 1894. Admission charged for the one-hour guided tour. Located on the south edge of Faulkton (900 8th Ave. S.) and operated by the Faulk County Historical Society. Other historical attractions in Faulkton include: **Maloney School and Faulk County Museum.**

### Arts Council

The Faulkton Area Arts Council and the Faulkton School cooperate annually to bring productions like the Children's Theatre of South Dakota to the community. FAAC also sponsors an art show, fall arts and crafts festival and many other activities throughout the year.



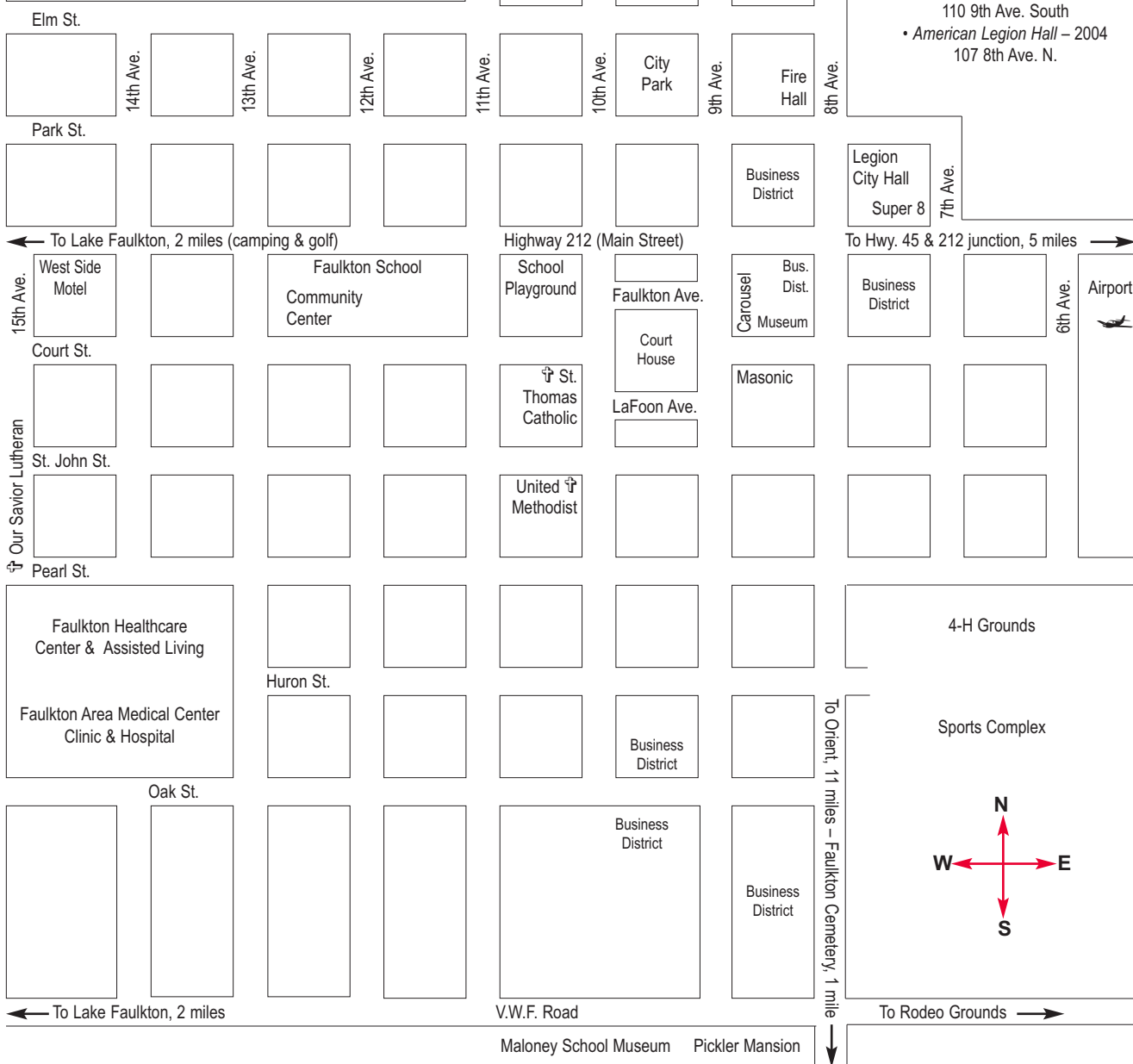
### Faulk County Courthouse

Built in 1905, this impressive three-story Omaha grey pressed brick building trimmed with Lake Superior brown sandstone continues to serve today as the Faulk County Courthouse. It is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Visit the courtroom and see the murals painted by local pioneer artist Charles T. Greener in 1906.



### City Parks

Faulkton City Park features this beautifully maintained garden area as well as abundant picnic shelter areas for large or small family gatherings. Baseball and two softball diamonds are located at the sports complex.

**Happy Times Carousel**

Faulkton's 1925 C.W. Parker electrically operated carousel features 19 original aluminum cast horses. Volunteers operate the carousel throughout the summer on Wednesday evenings, Saturday and Sunday afternoons and evenings (weather permitting). Free rides but donations gladly accepted. Inside the new carousel cover is a panoramic mural of Faulkton.
